POLICIES

- **ACADEMICS** - The first responsibility of the student athlete is to their academics. Each student will be monitored, counseled and given study time. Student athlete will be asked to be responsible for turning in an academic progress card biweekly. They will be expected to always do their best in school.
- **CITIZENSHIP** - All student athletes will be expected to conduct themselves in and out of the school environment according to the code of conduct above. Be a person of Character at all times.
- **ATTENDANCE** - Attendance and participation for all football functions is mandatory. If you are not in attendance you can't help the team.

 2. Make up practice sessions will take place 6:30 am sharp Tuesday in gym with Coach Wright
 3. No notification of absence will result in missing the next game
 4. Players missing 2 or more practices in 1 week will result in missing the next game.

The student athlete must be in attendance for full day on game day. Unless excused by Athletic Director.

- **SPORTSMANSHIP** - Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated.
- **ALCOHOL AND DRUG USE** - Illegal activities will not be tolerated. Self-reported problems will be dealt with individually and confidentially. If there is an abuse problem support will be given and consequences will follow.
- **APPERANCE** – Student athlete will be clean-shaven and hair kept short, neat, and trimmed during the football season.
- **INJURY**- Players must report all injuries to head coach. The referral to our certified athletic trainer Mark Ortiz will be made and any further referrals will be made. Injured player will dress out to practice in appropriate gear and will be involved with practice to extent they can. Treatment will take place before or after practice. Position coach will determine any loss of playing time.
